

NONDISCRIMINATION STATEMENT:

The Catholic schools of the Diocese of Colorado Springs, under the jurisdiction of Bishop Michael J. Sheridan and at the direction of the Director for Total Catholic Education, state that all of their Catholic schools admit students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the schools. Furthermore, Diocesan schools admit handicapped students in accord with Diocesan Policy No. 3000 concerning student admissions. These schools do not discriminate on the basis of race, age, handicap, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of their educational policies, employment practices, scholarship and loan programs or athletic or other school administered programs.
